FRIEDMUND NEUMANN PRIZE 2023

for outstanding basic research
of young scientists

The Schering Stiftung awards annually the Friedmund Neumann Prize to young scientists for outstanding basic research in human biology, organic chemistry or human medicine. The prize is directed at young scientists who have completed their dissertation and have already developed a distinctive scientific profile. The award aims to support them in their efforts to establish themselves as researchers and scientists. It carries a prize money of 10,000 EUR.

INFORMATION ON THE PRIZE & THE NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Prize money 10,000 EUR | There are no conditions attached to the prize money

Nomination criteria

- Excellent dissertation within the last 6 years (justified exceptions may be accepted). Please note the relevant info on our website.
- Work in Germany
- Outstanding scientific research in human biology, organic chemistry or human medicine
- The young scientist should have developed a unique profile that has great potential for the future, and he/she should work autonomously and independently of his/her supervisor. This should be reflected in the nominee's publications.
- Persons who already hold a tenured professorship or an equivalent permanent position will not be considered.
- Nominations will be accepted from well-established researchers and scientists (holders of chairs, directors of clinics, head of departments) as well as from scientific societies or organizations. Self-nominations are not accepted.

Submission deadline February 5, 2023

Nomination documents

- Nomination form of the Schering Stiftung (PDF at our website: www.scheringstiftung.de)
- CV with list of publications but without photograph
- Short summary of the nominee's research and statement by the nominating person why the nominee should receive the prize (3 pages, with letterhead and signature)
- Copies of three most important publications

• Please submit your nomination by email only, with all required documents combined into a single PDF file (10 MB max.).
